Andoung Snay Rural Water Supply System

1. The East Meets West Foundation (EMW) was established in Vietnam in 1988 and has a number of successful programs in education, health, school and hospital construction, dentistry, water and sanitation. EMW builds sustainable and catalytic solutions to difficult development problems. EMW's mission is to transform the health, education, and communities of disadvantages people in Asia. EMW achieves this mission by developing partnerships, creating opportunities and creating viable solutions.
2. EMW began working in Cambodia in early 2009 and has successfully completed one clean water project in Cambodia and over 120 community systems in Vietnam.
3. EMW invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for construction of a Rural Water Supply System for four villages in Andoung Snay Commune, Roleaphair District, Kampong Chhnang Province. The construction works comprise: treatment plant including mechanical and electrical works, elevated storage tank, and piped distribution system for approximately 500 households. The construction period is estimated to be approximately five months.
4. A pre-bid meeting will take place on **8 November 2012 at 4:00 p.m** at East Meets West office, address below. Bidding documents will be available for inspection at this meeting.
